

Greg's Resolve Keyboard Shortcuts

...most commonly used

Edit Workspace Shortcuts

Key Combination	Function
Q	Switches from source / viewer
Shift Z	Toggles zoom entire timeline
Cmd +/-	Zooms in/out of playhead
Tab / Enter	Allows direct timecode entry in source/viewer
Cmd F	Toggles full screen view
J K L	Play reverse, Stop, Play forward
P	Cinema Viewer

Editing Shortcuts

Key Combination	Function
I O	Marks In/Out in timeline, source or viewer
Option I O	Clears marked in/out
Option X	Clears both in/out
A	Normal edit mode
T	Trim mode
W	Dynamic trim mode
V	Select nearest edit point

Editing Shortcuts

Key Combination	Function
U	Edit point type (used in trim modes)
; ‘	First frame / Last frame
, •	Nudge one frame forward/backward
B	Blade edit
Cmd \	Inserts edit point at playhead
Delete	Delete selected
Shift Delete	Ripple delete

Editing Shortcuts

Key Combination	Function
M	Places marker at edit point or clip
Opt M	Removes marker, Opt-click marker extends
E	Extend edit
B	Blade edit
F9	Insert
F10	Overwrite
F11	Replace

Editing Shortcuts

Key Combination	Function
F	Match frame (loads clip into source)
Opt F	Finds selected clip in media pool
Cmd D	Clip duration
R	Change clip speed
Cmd R	Freeze Frame
Up/Down arrow	Previous/Next edit point
Home / End	Start/End of program

Selection Shortcuts

Key Combination	Function
Y	Select clips forward on this track
Cmd Y	Select clips backward on this track
Opt Y	Select all clips forward
Cmd Opt Y	Select all clips backwards
Option + Drag	Duplicates a clip(s) up, down, backwards, forwards
N	Toggles snapping
Cmd R, Opt Cmd R	Toggles retiming controls, Reset retiming controls
